People experience poverty when they lack, or are denied, economic, social and cultural resources to fully and meaningfully participate in the community.





Who is Living in Poverty?






In 2018, Edmonton's Food Bank had an average of 22,033 individuals a month receiving a food hamper. (Edmonton's Food Bank)
